Dear parents

We are looking forward to the start of a brand new school year!

Here is some important information for September. We are trialling some new start and finish routines, pending any other guidelines with regard to COVID-19 coming into school and we are looking forward to welcoming parents back into nursery at certain times of day.

Main entrance = Londesborough Road entrance

Red Door = Belgrave Crescent entrance

School start and finish times

8am – Early Starters	Please ring the buzzer at the main entrance and we will meet you and your child there (ALL CHILDREN). We will take your child in from the door so that you can get to work swiftly.		
830am – 9am (flexible drop-off) – Morning session starts 1230pm – Doors open – Afternoon session starts	Please come to the main reception (2 Year olds AND 3 & 4 year olds) and come into nursery with your child to drop them off (see below). Donna will be in Reception every day to help you.		
1120am doors open (collect by 1130am) – End of morning session 230pm – Early afternoon pick up time 320pm – doors open (collect by 330pm) – End of afternoon session	2 Year olds – Please collect from the Red Door. 3 & 4 year olds – Please collect children from the main entrance. We will have children ready with all their things and bring them out to you.		
Tea time club (collect up to 545pm) -	Please ring the buzzer at the main entrance and we will let you in to come and collect your child.		

New for 2021Lunch Club information......



We have new guidelines to follow which come into force in September 2021 linked to children's health and their oral health (teeth) in particular. We have a new duty to play our part, and will promote milk or water as the main drinks that support healthy young teeth.

New for September 2021 for all families!

We are trialling a new platform where we can securely share photographs of your child at nursery with you, and you can also share photographs of your child at home with us. It's called 'ClassDojo' and is used already by quite a few schools in the area.

If you already have an account (for children at another school) when you log in your nursery child will pop up like magic where your other children are!



Once you are logged in, you can see school news / pictures of your individual child and news from your key person. You can send your key person photographs from home and also send messages securely to them. You can access ClassDojo online or via a FREE app on your phone, which will keep you logged in all the time. Look out for your email (from next week).

Home Visits – We like to visit all new starters at home before they join us. We are thrilled that we are allowed to do this again for our new children. Home visits are **Tuesday 7**th – **Friday 10**th **September**. If you haven't heard from your key person yet, they will be in touch very soon to arrange your visit. Please have your 'I am Special' booklet and your essential information forms ready for the visit (inside your new starter pack).



Tea time club

We are now open until 5:45pm each night. The tea time club is an extension of the nursery day, with our own nursery staff. Please see Donna if you would like to book a session. These bookings can be adhoc (depending on our availability) should you need the additional sessions now and again, or they can use your regular nursery funded hours. Children will be provided with a light tea and be able to play indoors and out during the session. It is a flexible pick-up option, so that you can just arrive any time, with the latest pick up at 545pm. If your child is booked into tea time club and you need to contact us (e.g. someone different will be collecting them) please contact us before 330pm, as we cannot guarantee that there will by anyone in the school office after that time.

In addition to all the wonderful environments that the staff create for children, and their day to day adventures with them, these are the extra activities that we are offering at the moment as part of children's nursery experience.

This is a voluntary donation which goes towards additional activities such as food tasting and baking.




CAR PARKING – PLEASE HELP US

Our neighbours (on all sides) have asked us to remind parents that all the car parks at the main entrance to nursery (Londesborough Road) are private and NOT for use at drop off and pick up times. They are also NOT to be used as a cut through. They are now all CCTV monitored.

Please park and walk to nursery. There is ample parking at Sainsbury's across the road. There is also on-street parking on all the streets around nursery, such as Murray Street, All Saints Road and Avenue Road.



If you are collecting a 2 year old from the red door on Belgrave Crescent at 230pm or 330pm, please only park in a designated space (there are very few, and it is preferable to park on surrounding streets or Sainsbury's also). We have had fresh zig –zag lines painted which creates a safe zone outside that entrance. Please do not obstruct this or our adjoining neighbour's drive.
